

NOTICE TO STEEL FABRICATORS

Sealed proposals for the Steel H-Pile, Steel Sheet Pile, Sub-Structure Steel, Super-Structure Steel, Metal Decking, Deck Reinforcing Steel, and Bridge Guardrail for a 90'-0" long by 24'-6" wide roadway bridge in Knox County, Nebraska, "Steel Material for Crofton South Bridge Replacement Project," will be received by the Knox County Clerk, Joann Fischer, in her office at the Knox County Courthouse, until 11:00 am local time, on Wednesday, September 3, 2025, and thereafter will be opened and publicly read on Wednesday, September 3, 2025 at 11:00 am, at the Knox County Supervisor's meeting room, Knox County Courthouse, 206 Main Street, Center, NE 68724. Knox County Clerks' mailing/shipping address is: 206 Main Street (P.O. Box 166) Center, NE 68724.

Proposals will be taken for the steel material fabricated and delivered to the jobsite above by unit prices combined as an aggregate bid for the project. Knox County forces will be responsible for the removal of the existing bridge, construction of the proposed bridge, and the dirt work/grading operations.

The bridge crosses West Bow Creek and is located 0.2 West of the intersection of 552 Avenue and 887 Road. To drive to the bridge site, start at Hwy 12 and the Cedar/Knox County Line, travel 3.0 miles South on 552 Avenue, travel 0.2 mile West on 887th Road to the jobsite.

Plans and specifications, together with the General Conditions and Instructions to Bidders may be seen, examined, and secured at the office of the County Highway Superintendent, Mr. Kevin Barta, 310 Bridge Street (P.O. Box 85) Center, NE 68724. Phone: 402-288-5610.

All proposals for said work must be made on blanks furnished by the County Highway Superintendent and must be accompanied by bid security of not less than 5% of the amount bid. Bid security to be made payable to the County Clerk of Knox County, Nebraska, and will be held by Knox County as liquidated damages in case the bid is accepted and the bidder neglects or refuses to enter into contract and furnish bond in accordance herewith.

The Knox County Supervisors reserve the right to waive informalities and irregularities and to make awards on bids that furnish the steel material that will, in their opinion, serve the best interests of Knox County, Nebraska. The Knox County Supervisors also reserve the right to reject any or all bids.
