A regular meeting of the Knox County Board of Equalization was held in the Boardroom at the Knox County Courthouse in Center, Nebraska on the date of Wednesday, September 3, 2025 at 9:59 a.m. Present were Supervisors Martin J. O'Connor District #1, Kevin G. Mlady District #2, David L. Pierce District #3, James Sokol, Jr. District #4, Kevin D. Mackeprang District #5, Danny R. Schlote District #6 and James J. Borgmann District #7. Absent was none. Chairman Schlote presiding.

Also, the Osmond Community Schools in Pierce County will be participating at the Pierce County joint public hearing and "pink" postcards will be mailed to Knox County real estate owners whose real estate is in the Osmond School District; 2.) Update on a recent training County Assessor Beckmann and Deputy County Assessor Kracht attended.


The public comment session at held at 10:04 a.m. No one gave public comment.
