A regular meeting of the Knox County Board of Equalization was held in the Boardroom at the Knox County Courthouse in Center, Nebraska on the date of Wednesday, December 24, 2025 at 10:03 a.m. Present were Supervisors Martin J. O'Connor District #1, Kevin G. Mlady District #2, David L. Pierce District #3, James Sokol, Jr. District #4, Kevin D. Mackeprang District #5, Danny R. Schlote District #6 and James J. Borgmann District #7. Absent was none. Chairman Schlote presiding.

Chairman Schlote announced to the public that a copy of the Public Open Meeting Act was posted in the Boardroom.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Crofton Journal newspaper, as shown by the Affidavit of Publication attached to these minutes.

Notice of this meeting was simultaneously given to all members and a copy of their acknowledgment and receipt of notice and agenda is attached to these minutes. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was opened to the attendance of the public.

County Clerk Fischer read the December 10, 2025 meeting minutes. Chairman Schlote approved the minutes of the December 10, 2025 meeting.

County Assessor Beckmann met with the Board on the following: 1.) Motion by Supr. Sokol, Jr., seconded by Supr. Pierce to approve Tax List Correction #8027 City of Bloomfield as property was sold to an exempt entity before levy date and should have no tax due. Comment on the motion was given by Supr. Mackeprang who said that his wife owns one-half interest in the property that was deeded to the City of Bloomfield and he would need to abstain from voting. By roll call vote. Ayes Districts #1, #2, #3, #4, #6 and #7. Nays none. Abstain District #5. Motion carried; 2.) Office update.
