A regular meeting of the Knox County Board of Equalization was held in the Boardroom at the Knox County Courthouse in Center, Nebraska on the date of Wednesday, April 29, 2026 at 9:58 a.m. Present were Supervisors Martin J. Borgmann District #7. Absent was none. Chairman Schlote presiding.

Chairman Schlote announced to the public that a copy of the Public Open Meeting Act was posted in the Boardroom.

County Clerk Fischer read the April 15, 2026 meeting minutes. Chairman Schlote approved the minutes of the April 15, 2026 meeting.




