A regular meeting of the Knox County Board of Equalization was held in the Boardroom at the Knox County Courthouse in Center, Nebraska on the date of Wednesday, July 22, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. Present were Supervisors Kevin G. Mlady District #2, David L. Pierce District #3, James Sokol, Jr. District #4, Danny R. Schlote District #6 and James J. Borgmann District #7. Absent were Supervisors Martin J. O'Connor District #1 and Kevin D. Mackeprang District #5. Chairman Schlote presiding.

Chairman Schlote announced to the public that a copy of the Public Open Meeting Act was posted in the Boardroom.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Wausa Gazette newspaper, as shown by the Affidavit of Publication attached to these minutes.

Flenniken so real estate tax was accelerated using the 2025 levy. By roll call vote. Ayes Districts #2, #3, #4, #6 and #7. Nays none. Absent were Districts #1 and #5. Motion carried.

Motion by Supr. Mlady, seconded by Supr. Borgmann to place on file the 3-Year Appraisal Plan. By roll call vote. Ayes Districts #2, #3, #4, #6 and #7. Nays none. Absent were Districts #1 and #5. Motion carried.

The public comment session was held at 10:16 a.m. No one gave public comments.

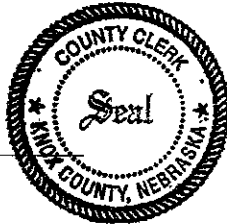

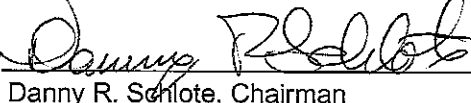
